What happens next?

We will review the information that you have sent us and we write to you if we need any further information or documents about your case. Please do not send us paperwork about your case unless we have asked for it.

We try and answer all the requests for help that relate to criminal appeals but as we are a small charity it may take us weeks or months to write back to you.

Will I be successful?

Unfortunately, due to our size and limited funding we can only take on a small number of cases each year and we reject most of the applications we receive. This does not mean that we consider you have not been wrongfully convicted or unfairly sentenced but we do advise that if you need legal help you should continue with your search for a lawyer elsewhere.
